Purdue Pharma LP.*, et al., Case No. 1:20-op-45149-DAP, pending in the United States District Court for the Northern District of Ohio, and related litigation, including potential resolution of certain claims against opioids manufacturers, Alvogen, Amneal, Apotex, Hikma, Indivior, Mylan, Sandoz, Sun, and Zydus and taking appropriate action in open session, including possible authorization to settle claims, the disclosure of which may seriously impair the litigation if known by public disclosure as allowed by 25 O.S. § 307(B)(4).

Consider approving voting to participate in the proposed nationwide settlement agreement against opioids manufacturers, Alvogen, Amneal, Apotex, Hikma, Indivior, Mylan, Sandoz, Sun, and Zydus that were identified in the Court's June 22, 2022 and October 7, 2022 Orders. Including approval of Resolution No. 2025-73, and authorize the Chair of the Board of County Commissioners to execute the Subdivision Participation Form for the County of Coal's participation in the opioids manufacturers settlements.
